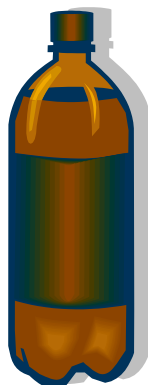
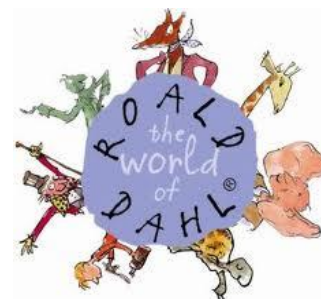
MACMILLAN COFFEE MORNING

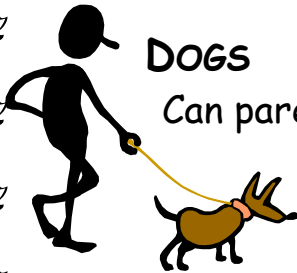
Juniors - the Hall.

Junior Disco: 4:30pm-5:30pm - Cost £1. No ticket required, pay on the door, refreshments available to purchase.

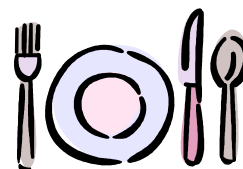
Forthcoming Events: Table Top Sale - Saturday, 29 November:
