As you are probably aware, all Year 6 children take National Curriculum tests in English and Maths. We are thrilled to inform you of our Year 6 SATs results for 2013/14:

Combined level 4+ in English and Maths = 78%

Reading Level 4+ = 81%

Writing Level 4+ = 81%

Maths Level 4+ = 81%

Last year the Academy was below the Government floor target of 60% combined. This year the floor target is 65% and we are incredibly proud of our leaving Year 6 children who worked incredibly hard to achieve so well. We wish them all the best in their new Secondary schools. A huge thank you must also go to all the staff who work tirelessly and with commitment to improve the education of our children.

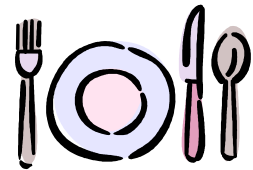
