

Assessing without Levels

The Government provides clear guidance regarding the standards that children should reach by the end of each year. It is important that we recognise the hard work and individual achievements of children whilst also being aware of how they are progressing compared to children of the same age nationally.

At Moorhead Academy, we split the journey to the Expected Standard into 5 steps – the expectation is that children make 1 step of progress each term. Therefore the standard that they should achieve each term is as follows:
