Raffle tickets for the above need to be back at the Academy no later than the **morning of Friday 26th June.**

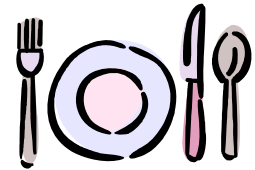
