This will take place on **Wednesday, 15 July**, and there are two performances: 9:30am and 4pm. Your child will have brought a letter home with a slip to return to order tickets.



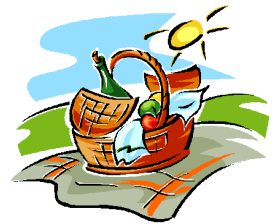

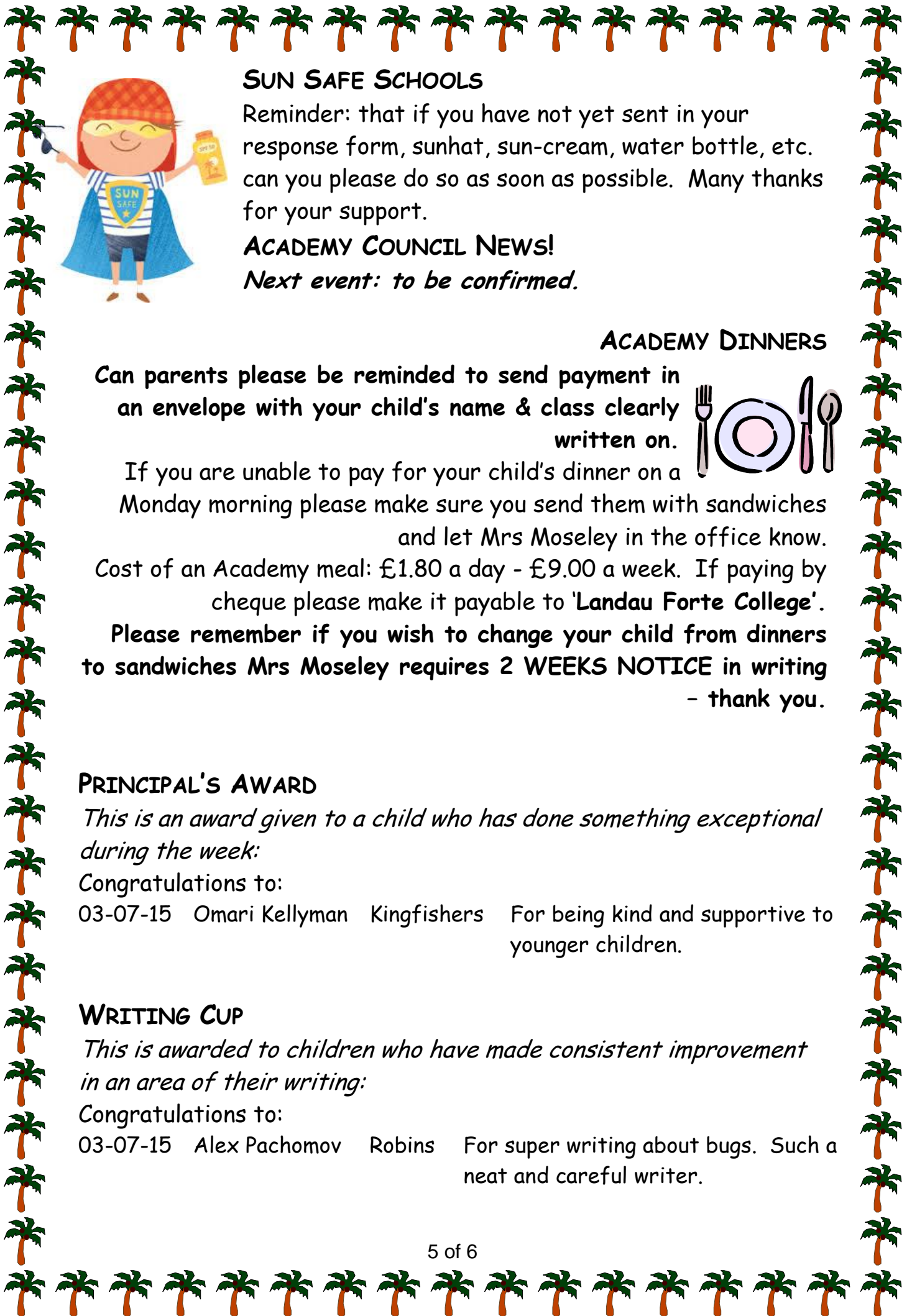

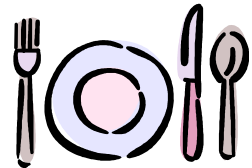
Reminder: that if you have not yet sent in your response form, sunhat, sun-cream, water bottle, etc. can you please do so as soon as possible. Many thanks for your support.
