




LANDAU FORTE ACADEMY MOORHEAD NEWSLETTER

Infants - 3:15pm-4:15pm - admission by ticket only - cost £2, available from the office until Thursday, 14 April.

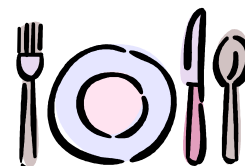
Juniors - 4:30pm-5:30pm - pay on the door - cost £1. May bring money to spend on drinks, crisps, etc.

Summer Fayre Meeting, Wednesday, 18 May, at 3:15pm in Cranes - to discuss stalls, games, etc - all welcome to attend.


ACADEMY DINNERS
