available from the office until **Thursday, 9 June.**

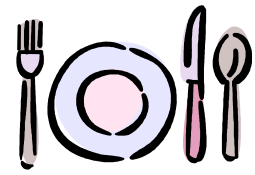
Juniors - 4:30pm-5:30pm - pay on the door - cost £1. May bring money to spend on drinks, crisps, etc.
