We are proud to work in partnership with our community and together we challenge ourselves to achieve more.

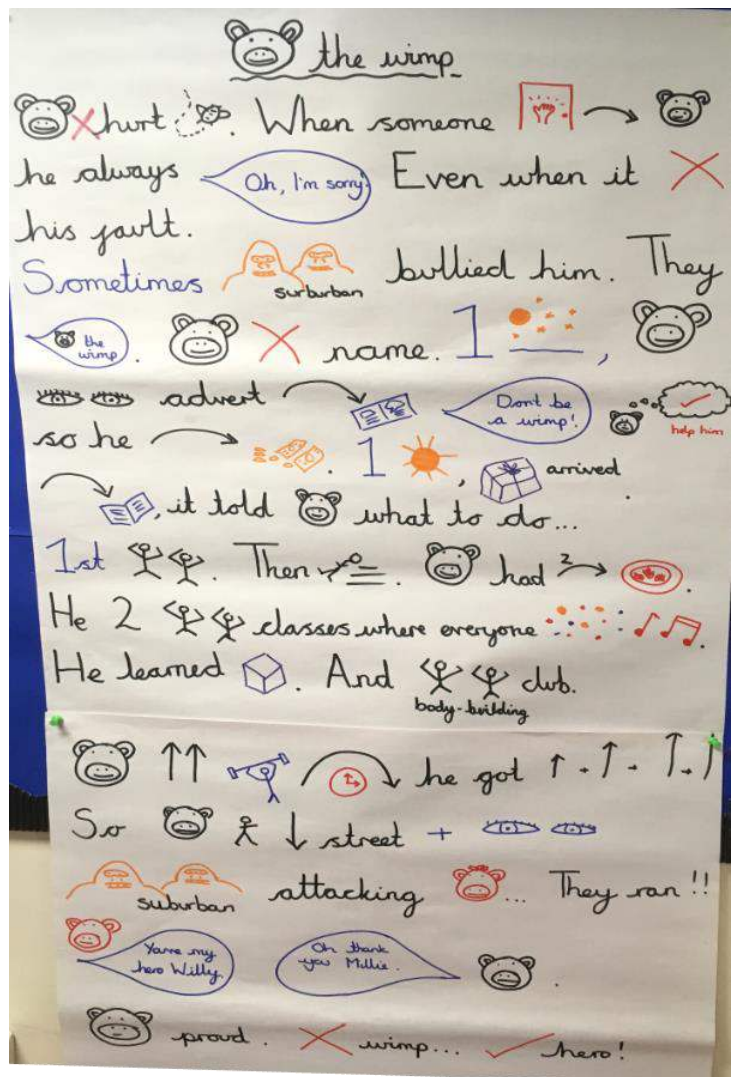
## What's been happening at Moorhead:

## Coming up:

### HEALTHY SCHOOL BREAKFAST

Our Academy is joining forces with the Government's National School Breakfast Programme, being delivered by the charities Family Action and Magic Breakfast. What it means is that we will be offering a healthy school breakfast, available to all, as part of our existing Breakfast Club provision which starts at 7.30am.

As the food is now being provided by the Government, we are able to reduce the charge for the Breakfast Club from £2.50 per day, down to £2.30 per day. If you are eligible for Free School Meals, please speak to Mrs Cooper in the School Office, or Miss Dashfield, our Family Support Worker. Booking a place at the Breakfast Club should continue to be done through the Office staff.

In addition, we will be making available bagels at around 8.50am in the classrooms. These will be offered free of charge and are designed to ensure that in addition to the breakfast parents and carers provide, the children are settled and ready to learn right at the start of the academy day.

If you wish to apply for Free School Meals, please contact Mrs Tatem, PA to the Headteacher, in confidence about completing an application.
