SCHOOL LUNCH

Unfortunately, due to rising food prices, we will have to increase the cost of a school lunch from the current £2.00 (which we have held for many years now), to £2.10 per day. This price increase will take effect from the beginning of the new school year in September and still represents excellent value for money.



It is important that children get a balanced and nutritious meal and all our dinners provide the children with variety and choice at the same time as providing the important nutrients. The popularity of our dinners has increased so that over 1,000 per week are being served.

As ever, if you believe you qualify for Free School Meals then please collect a form from the School Office to apply.

Even if your child currently is eligible for Universal Free School Meals (Reception-Year 2) you can still apply, as school gets funding for every successful application.

YEAR 6 TRANSITION DAYS AT NOEL- BAKER ACADEMY TUESDAY 2ND, WEDNESDAY 3RD AND THURSDAY 4TH JULY 2019

On **Tuesday 2nd July at 9.00am**, all year 6 students joining Noel-Baker in September will attend a **three-day programme** which will involve a range of 'taster' lessons and activities.

Your child will need to go directly to Noel-Baker arriving by 9.00am, on the Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings. On arrival your child should go towards the academy main reception entrance, where members of staff will greet and welcome your child. **If you are collecting your child at the end of each day, please wait outside the main school reception at 3.10pm.**

A free lunch will be provided during the three days. If your child does not want a lunch from the canteen they must bring a packed lunch. We advise that your child brings a bottle of water as Noel-Baker have water fountains on site. They will be allowed to have water with them in all the activities.
