## REMINDERS:

### SCHOOL LUNCH

Unfortunately, due to rising food prices, we will have to increase the cost of a school lunch from the current £2.00 (which we have held for many years now), to £2.10 per day. This price increase will take effect from the beginning of the new school year in September and still represents excellent value for money.



It is important that children get a balanced and nutritious meal and all our dinners provide the children with variety and choice at the same time as providing the important nutrients. The popularity of our dinners has increased so that over 1,000 per week are being served.

As ever, if you believe you qualify for Free School Meals then please collect a form from the School Office to apply.

Even if your child currently is eligible for Universal Free School Meals (Reception-Year 2) you can still apply, as school gets funding for every successful application.

### MEDICATION IN SCHOOL

The only medicine that can be administered in school is prescribed medication. This must be handed into the school office by the parent/carer in the original prescribed packaging, where you will be asked to complete and sign a medicine consent form.
