Their report highlighted the particularly good progress in Leadership and Management and in Early Years education, which has built on our previous announced significant improvement in Phonics.

I am also delighted by the support we have received from the Landau Forte Charitable Trust to ensure we are able to make this progress. The Trust will continue to offer this support as we move from strength to strength. Despite the challenges we have faced this year, I have been delighted by the attitude and commitment of our pupils at Landau Forte Academy Moorhead, and I know that we have a bright future ahead of us. Thank you to all our parents and carers all for your help – I have loved working with the Moorhead community and I am grateful for the support we have received from our families.

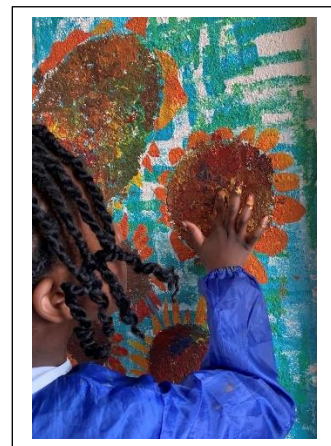
## Forest Schools at LFADM

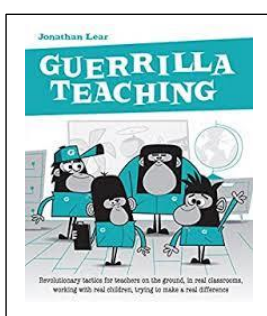
## Enrichment Clubs




## NEW STAFF! - Welcome to Mrs Emma Dibden
