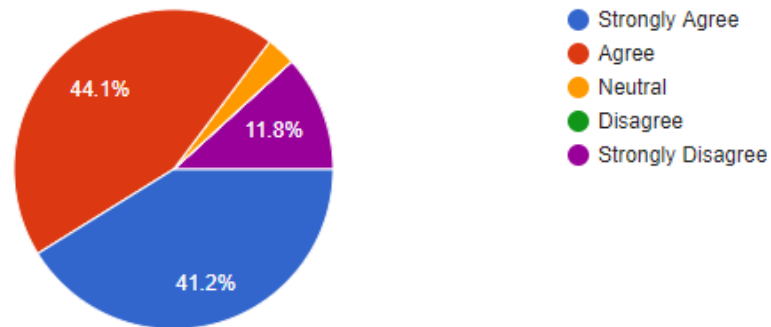


Parent Consultation Analysis

Landau Forte Academy Moorhead received 34 responses.

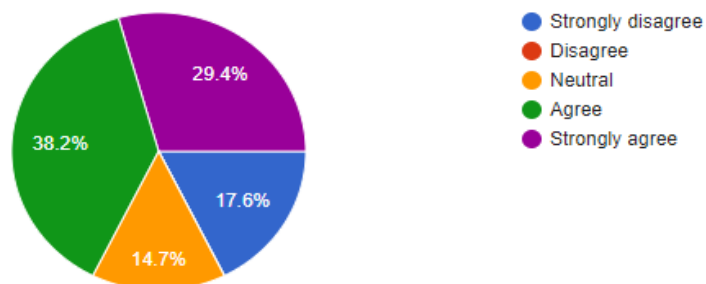
I think PHSE/RSE education is an important part of the school curriculum.

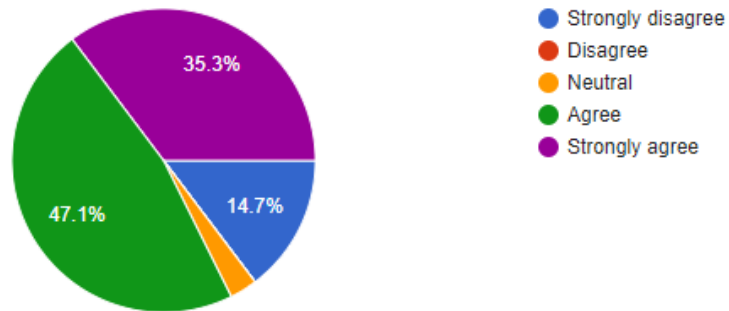
PSHE/RSE topics taught in school can make a real difference to young people's lives

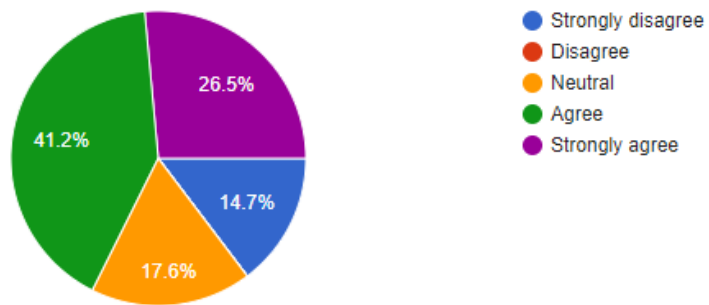
I feel happy to talk to my child about growing up, sex and relationships

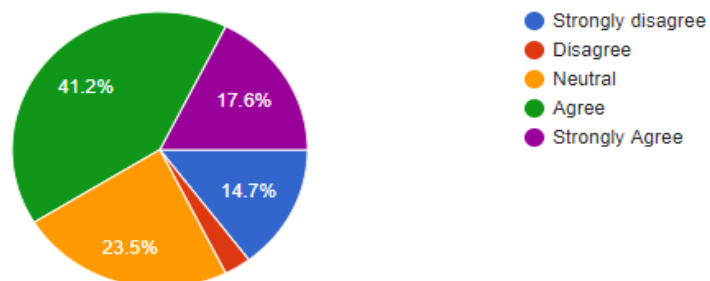
I understand and agree with the content of the PSHE/RSE policy.
