Lesson 2	Retrieval – Identifying key details from a text helps children to understand the text – also holds a large weighting in the SATs papers. (2 nd highest question domain in last 4 years SATS papers 2016-19)				
Lesson 3 and 4	Choose one of the following domains for last two lessons of the week — • Inference • Summarising • Compare and contrast • Prediction • Author choice Over a period of 4 weeks, each of these domains should be taught at least once and inference should be taught at least twice.
